Indian Languages: Hindi Studies Urdu Studies Tamil Studies Telugu Studies Marathi Studies	(i) A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings <u>or</u> passes not below grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education 'Ordinary Level'. Note 1 <i>Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at 'Principal Level' and one subject at 'Subsidiary Level' as well as the General Paper, not below grade C, obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.</i>
Chinese Studies	(ii) Passes in at least two subjects at Advanced/Principal Level, one of which should be relevant to the course.
Fine Arts: Fine Arts Digital Arts	OR Alternative qualifications acceptable to the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.
Indological Studies: Indian Philosophy Sanskrit	Note 2 <i>For the Diploma in Sanskrit Programme, candidates should possess qualifications set out at (i) & (ii) above and should also have the Foundation Course in Sanskrit Certificate.</i>
Performing Arts : Bharata Natyam Kathak Kuchipudi Sitar Mridangam Tabla Vocal Carnatic Music Vocal Hindustani Music	(i) A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings <u>or</u> passes not below grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education 'Ordinary Level'. Note <i>Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at 'Principal Level' and one subject at 'Subsidiary Level' as well as the General Paper, not below grade C, obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.</i> (ii) Passes in at least two subjects at Advanced/Principal Level; and (iii) Certificate in Indian Music/Dance, as appropriate, from Mahatma Gandhi Institute OR Alternative qualifications acceptable to the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

Course Fees : Rs 3000/- (Refundable subject to conditions)
